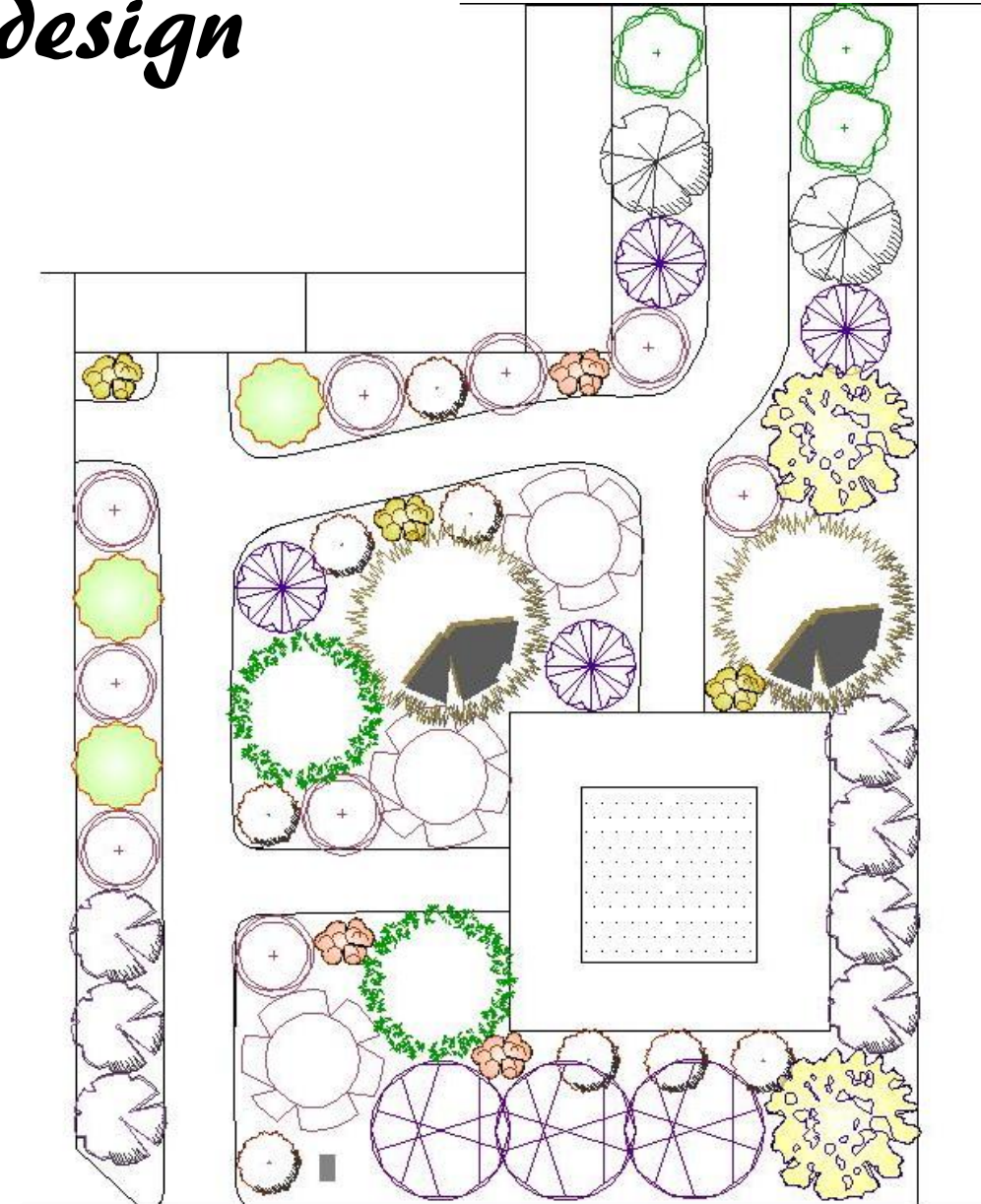
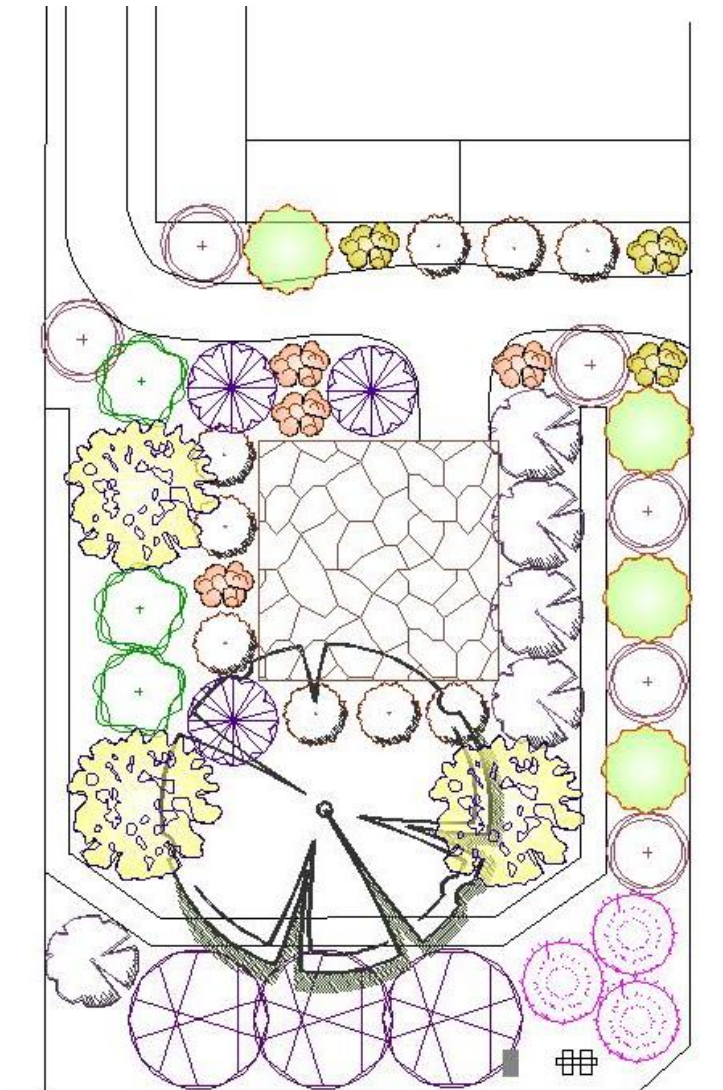

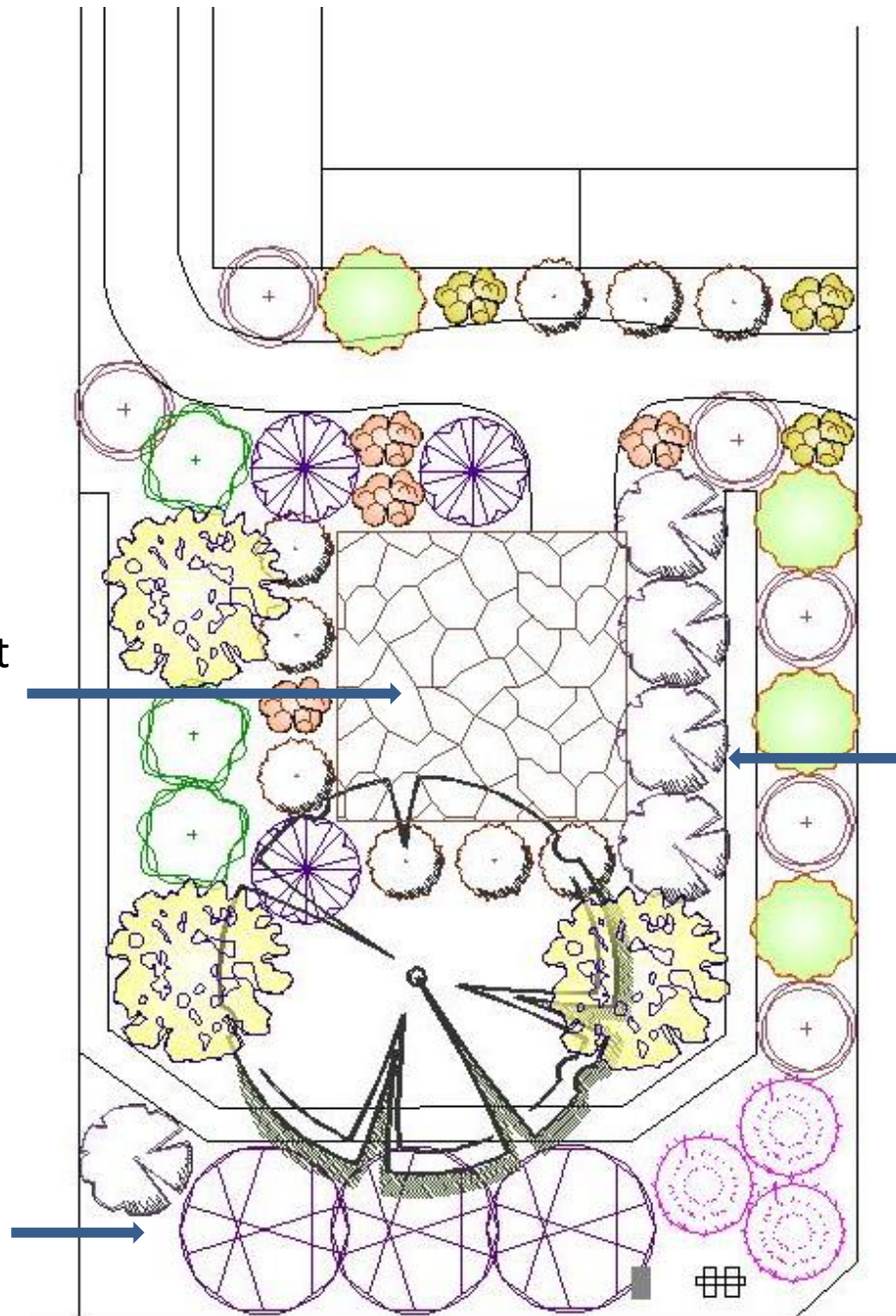

Cobblestone along front edge to keep bark chips off road

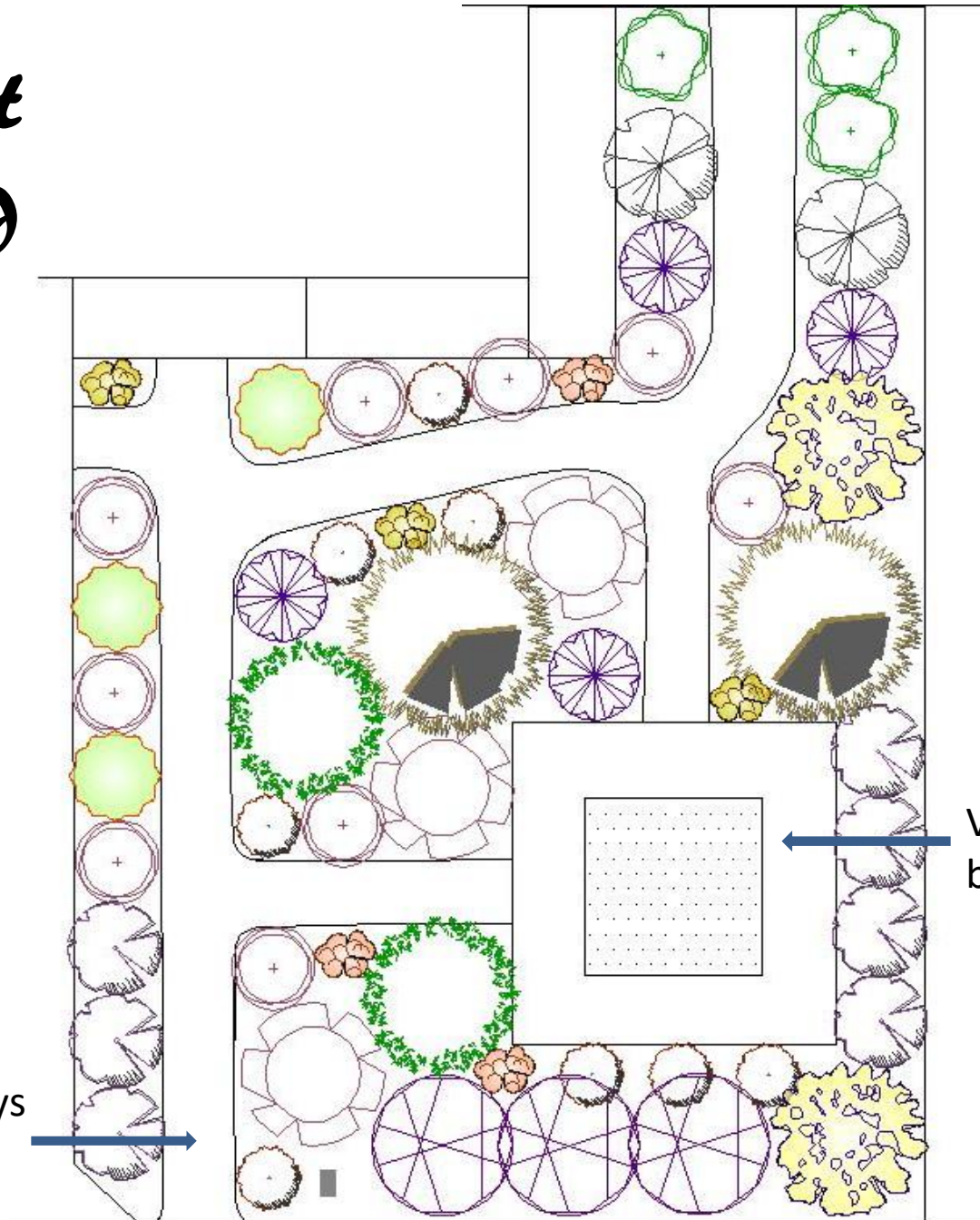


Garden Block retaining wall to level out front yard

# Material Choices



Garden Block – for the retaining wall (left side)



Redwood – for the raised garden bed (right side)



Pavers – for the patio area (left side)



Decomposed Granite (DG) – for the pathways



Cobble Stone – for edge alongside the road



Bark Chips – for around the plants
